The RSUs will be settled in either Common Stock or cash (or a combination thereof) at the discretion of the Issuer's compensation committee. The remaining RSUs vest on the third anniversary of April 1, 2022, subject to the Reporting Person's continued employment.
- 4. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Common Stock. The RSUs will be settled in either Common Stock or cash (or a combination thereof) at the discretion of the Issuer's compensation committee. The remaining RSUs vest on the second and third anniversaries of April 1, 2023, subject to the Reporting Person's continued employment.
- 5. Represents additional RSUs granted to the Reporting Person on April 1, 2024. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Common Stock. The RSUs will be settled in either Common Stock or cash (or a combination thereof) at the discretion of the Issuer's compensation committee. The RSUs shall vest in one-third increments upon the first, second and third anniversaries of the vesting reference date, April 1, 2024, subject to the Reporting Person's continued employment.
